WHAT IS A BONDED WAREHOUSE?

A bonded warehouse is a secure facility authorized by customs authorities—such as U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) or the Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA)—where imported goods can be stored without immediate payment of duties or taxes. Duties are deferred until the goods are withdrawn for domestic consumption. In the U.S., goods can remain in a bonded warehouse for up to five years.
